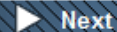

The Stockyards

Game to try something different? How about a 20-ounce buffalo rib eye? Buffalo meat is leaner than beef, so order it on the rare side to preserve juiciness. Farm-raised, its flavor is similar to beef without gaminess. With sides, \$52.
